**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND  
ADOPTING THE EMERGENCY SUPPORT FUNCTION ANNEXES TO THE  
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE U.S. HOMELAND  
SECURITY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTY  
EMERGENCY PLANNING EFFORTS**

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**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Richmond may be exposed to serious risks as a result of our natural and industrial environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is responsible for the preparation and carrying out of plans, and the training, exercising and updating of those plans, for the protection of persons, property, the environment, as well as recovery, within this City in the event of a disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to minimize loss of life, property, or environmental damage, resulting from identified disasters, the City of Richmond has prepared these Emergency Support Function Annexes to complement the existing Emergency Operations Plan to ensure the most effective and economical allocation and coordination of resources for the maximum benefit and protection of the civilian population in times of disasters, and to expedite recovery operations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Emergency Support Function Annexes is the grouping of governmental, external agencies and certain private sector capabilities into an organizational structure to provide support, resources, program implementation, and services that are most likely needed to save lives, protect property and the environment, restore essential services and critical infrastructure, and help victims including our community with disabilities and access and functional needs to return to normalcy following domestic incidents; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the City Council adopts the Emergency Support Function Annexes created by the City of Richmond Emergency Manager effective 2019.
