

ORDINANCE NO. 1-96 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AMENDING CHAPTER 3.16 OF THE RICHMOND MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE LIBRARY COMMISSION.

The Council of the City of Richmond do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.16.010 of the Richmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.16.010 Membership. There is created a library commission of the City which shall consist of five commissioners appointed by the Mayor with the concurrence of the City Council. Each of the commissioners shall be a registered voter residing within the City and shall have terms of three years. Any vacancy upon the library commission shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor with the concurrence of the City Council. No member of the commission shall serve for more than two consecutive full terms. The absence of any member of the commission from more than three regularly scheduled meetings of the commission within any twelve-consecutive-month period shall constitute an automatic resignation from the commission. Such resignation shall not, however, disqualify an individual from subsequently being appointed to the same or any other City commission or board.

Section 2. The provisions of Section 3.16.010 delineating the length of terms of members of the commission shall operate prospectively so as to apply only to those members of the commission that are appointed after the adoption of the Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective after its final passage and adoption.
