RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND PERTAINING TO THE NUMBER OF TERMS THAT CAN BE SERVED BY A DIRECTOR OF THE SHIMADA FRIENDSHIP COMMISSION

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Richmond that Section 3(a) of Resolution No. 8337 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) The terms of five (5) Directors shall expire at the end of the odd numbered calendar year next following that in which their appointments become effective, and the terms of the other Directors shall expire at the end of the even numbered calendar year next following that in which their appointments become effective. Thereafter, Directors shall be appointed to serve for a term of two years. No Director shall serve for more than four consecutive full terms.
