## Request for Withdrawal of Voter Signature from Petition

(California Elections Code Section 9602)

A voter who has signed an initiative or referendum petition, and who subsequently wishes his or her name withdrawn, may do so by filing a written request for the withdrawal with the City Clerk. This request shall be filed in the City Clerk's office prior to the date the petition is filed.

This Request for Withdrawal must contain the following:

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The original Request for Withdrawal must be received in the City Clerk's Office **no later than 5 p.m. the day before** the date the petition is filed. No fax, e-mailed, or scanned copies will be accepted for filing.
