



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on **Tuesday, December 17, 2019**, at the hour of 6:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the City Council will conduct its fourth public hearing at the Community Services Building, 440 Civic Center Plaza to consider the following item:

**Introduce an ordinance that will adopt a “by-district” election system for electing City Council Members, as well as the voting district boundaries and the election sequence.**

The City Council adopted **Resolution of Intention No. 99-19** on October 22, 2019, to transition from at-large to by-district elections in order to ensure compliance with the California Voting Rights Act of 2001 (“CVRA”) and Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965 (“FVRA”). At the public hearing described in this notice, the City Council may receive staff presentations regarding the draft district maps, discuss the draft maps, and potentially eliminate some of the draft maps from further consideration.

All interested persons are invited to present their views and comments on this matter. Written statements may be filed with the City Clerk, City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, 3rd Floor, Richmond, 94804, at any time prior to the hearing scheduled herein, and oral statements may be made at said hearing.

If you challenge the subject matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk, 450 Civic Center Plaza, 3rd Floor, at or prior to the close of the public hearing.
