<p><b>Businesses and residents are encouraged to donate <u>only</u> the following types of protective medical supplies:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eye protection, such as goggles and face shields</li> <li>• Antibacterial and disinfecting wipes, typically alcohol or bleach based (<b>unopened</b>). <b>NO</b> baby wipes.</li> <li>• N-95 and surgical masks (<b>unused</b>)</li> <li>• Waterproof gowns, coveralls and sleeved aprons</li> <li>• Hand-sewn cloth masks</li> </ul>	<p><b>Donations will be distributed to emergency child care/family care centers who are providing child care specifically to children of our essential work force:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Toilet paper</li> <li>• Paper towels</li> <li>• Surgical type gloves</li> <li>• Household grade disinfectant spray</li> <li>• Household grade disinfectant wipes</li> </ul>	<p><b>The following items will be distributed to patients in need who test positive for COVID-19:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New pillows (in packaging)</li> <li>• New blankets (in packaging)</li> <li>• New shower shoes</li> <li>• Sweatshirts (clean)</li> </ul>
