


Firearm Incidents Causing Injury or Death Prevented

Gun Violence Reduction Work

- 4,443** Street Outreach + Fellow Contacts
- 7,917** Hours of engagement
- 248** Service referrals
- 28** Imminent gun violence conflicts interrupted
- 88** Community conflicts mediated that could have escalated into gun violence
- 27** Shootings responded to – ONS helped avoid further retaliatory violence
