Nominated members must be residents or individuals who operate a business or organization in the project area, and may include youth 16 and older. The Committee will review all submitted nomination forms and appoint community members that best reflect the neighborhoods and values served by the Richmond Rising programs. Appointment of community members requires a two-thirds vote of the Committee.

Appointed members are invited to serve through September 2028. However, the Committee understands that this commitment may not be possible and asks that adult members (25+) serve at least two years. Youth members are expected to serve at least one year.

Community members appointed to the Committee will be reimbursed \$50 per meeting attended. Please reach out to tcc@ci.richmond.ca.us with any questions you may have.
