On Wednesday, May 7, 2025, at 9:56 a.m., officers from the Richmond Police Department responded to the 4500 block of Florida Ave for a report of a man with a gun. The victim reported that her child's father had arrived at her residence while armed with an assault style rifle. The suspect threatened the victim with the firearm. The victim was able to successfully flee the residence with her child, leaving the suspect alone inside the residence.

Officers quickly responded and began to establish a perimeter around the location. While setting up the perimeter, the suspect exited the residence, and officers were able to track his movements from a distance away. Officers briefly lost sight of the suspect and believed he had re-entered the residence. Officers attempted unsuccessfully to make contact with the suspect. A perimeter was established while officers continued to attempt to make contact.

After failing to contact the suspect and obtaining a search warrant, RPD SWAT team members conducted a physical search of the residence. Officers determined that the suspect was not inside the residence and had managed to escape the perimeter.

A search of the residence did result in an assault rifle being recovered (See attached photo). At this time, the suspect, Javon Hudson, is still outstanding.
