Richmond, CA – At approximately 8:00 a.m. today, Richmond Police officers responded to the area of 22nd Street and Florida Avenue in search of a known suspect wanted on multiple felony charges. Officers located the suspect inside a parked vehicle in an apparent attempt to avoid detection.

As officers approached, the suspect abruptly reversed his vehicle, ramming a marked Richmond Police Department patrol car. The suspect then accelerated forward, crashing into a second marked patrol vehicle occupied by two officers. The suspect fled the scene, initiating a high-speed pursuit through the City of Richmond and onto the freeway in the direction of Oakland.

During the course of the pursuit, the suspect collided with another vehicle, disabling his own vehicle. Officers quickly moved in and safely took the suspect into custody without further incident.

One Richmond Police officer sustained injuries during the arrest and was treated and released from the hospital. The suspect also received medical treatment and was subsequently released and booked into jail.

We are grateful that no members of the public were seriously harmed and that our injured officer is recovering.

The investigation remains ongoing.
