Sexual Battery Incidents Point Richmond

Richmond, CA—On 6/8/25, at 11:45 AM, the Richmond Police Department received a report of a sexual battery that occurred in the Point Richmond Tunnel. The victim was approached by the suspect while inside the tunnel. The suspect made unwanted physical contact before fleeing on foot. The suspect was described as a black male, approximately 40-50 years old, weighing 200 lbs., with a bald head and a gray/white goatee. He was wearing an off-white and blue shirt with gray pants.

On 6/11/25, at 7:50 PM, the Richmond Police Department received a report of a sexual battery that occurred in the Point Richmond Tunnel. The victim was also jogging when she was approached by the suspect, who made unwanted physical contact. The suspect was described as a black male in his 40s, 5'8", 200lbs, black loose-fitting jogging pants, cap with black bill, gray hoodie with blue and yellow design.

On 7/15/25, at 9:36 AM, the Richmond Police Department received a report of a sexual battery that occurred in the Point Richmond Tunnel. The victim was walking in the Point Richmond Tunnel and saw the suspect also walking in the tunnel. As the victim attempted to walk past the suspect, the suspect made unwanted physical contact with the victim. The victim was able to get the attention of a passing motorist, who stopped, prompting the suspect to flee on foot. The suspect was described as a black male, 45-50 years old, 5'7", average build, short hair, wearing a gray sweatshirt with red letters and dark colored pants.

Based on the locations of these incidents and the suspect's description, it is believed that the same individual is responsible for these three sexual assaults.
