RICHMOND POLICE CASE 25-12038 (Updated)

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Richmond, CA - On December 15, 2025, at approximately 12:06 PM, the Richmond Police Department Communications Center received multiple reports of a fight in the 800 block of Chanslor Avenue. While officers were responding, additional callers reported that shots had been fired.

Officers arrived and located a large group outside Sylvester Greenwood Academy at 831 Chanslor Avenue. The initial investigation determined that a large fight occurred outside the school involving both students and adults. During the altercation, a suspect produced a firearm and fired at least one round. No one was struck or injured by the gunfire. The school building sustained minor damage after being struck by at least one bullet.

The suspect fled the area prior to officers' arrival. As a precaution, Sylvester Greenwood Academy and the neighboring Leadership Public Schools campus were briefly placed on lockdown while officers secured the area and conducted their investigation. Both schools remained in session.

As part of the ongoing follow-up investigation, the Richmond Police Department SWAT Team executed a search warrant this morning in North Richmond. As a result, four suspects were detained for various charges related to the fight that preceded the gunfire, including felony battery.
