Richmond Police Arrest Volleyball Coach in Ongoing Sexual Abuse Investigation

Richmond, CA – The Richmond Police Department Special Victims Unit (SVU) has arrested a Richmond man following a months-long investigation involving allegations of an inappropriate relationship between an adult staff member and a juvenile student.

On September 17, 2025, Richmond Police officers responded to Kennedy High School after the school and a parent called to report a suspected inappropriate relationship involving a staff member and a juvenile student. Officers took the initial report, and SVU detectives assumed responsibility for the investigation.

During the preliminary investigation, detectives developed probable cause to arrest the staff member, Timothy Logan, a 49-year-old Richmond resident, for violations of Penal Code 261.5 – Unlawful Sexual Intercourse with a Minor. Following his initial arrest, Logan posted bail and was later released from custody as the investigation continued.

SVU detectives continued investigative efforts, including forensic examinations of digital evidence, which led to further criminal charges.

On January 23, 2026, the Contra Costa County District Attorney's Office filed the following charges against Logan:

- Two counts of Penal Code 288(c)(1)
- One count of Penal Code 288.3(a)
- One count of Penal Code 647.6(a)(1)

On February 2, 2026, Logan was located and arrested by Richmond Police SVU detectives in Antioch. He was booked into jail on the above charges with bail set at \$225,000.00. Logan remains in custody.

The school where Logan was employed took immediate action and terminated his employment on September 17, 2025.

The Richmond Police Department is proud of the thorough work of our SVU detectives in this investigation and remains committed to protecting our youth and holding offenders accountable. We hope this arrest brings progress toward healing for the victim and their family.
